



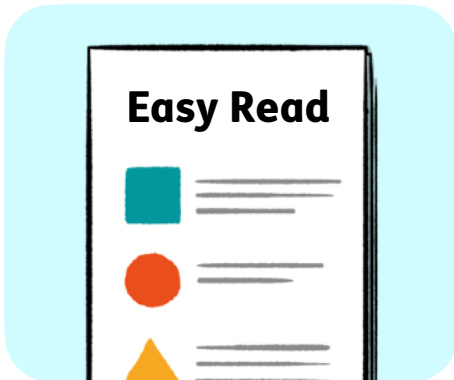

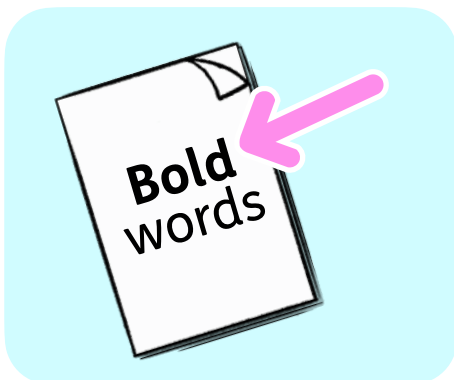


This is an Easy Read version of some information.

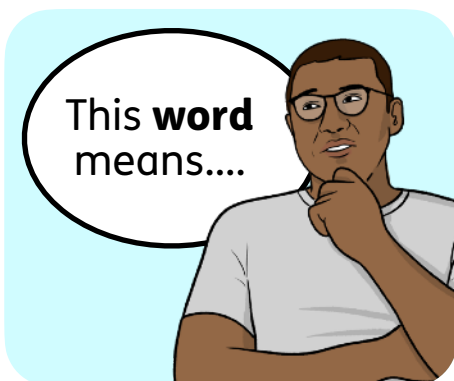
It uses easier words and pictures.

- Make sure all our customers and visitors feel included when they visit us.

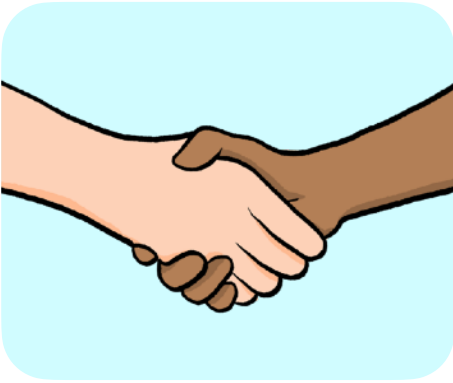


- Listen to what people with different disabilities say they need.

We also want to:



- Work with experts in accessibility.



- Be honest about what we can and cannot do.

# How we will follow our plan

By 2030, we will:



- Work with visitors to help everyone take part in our events and experiences.



- Give staff training on how to include and support people with different needs and disabilities.



- Write a report every year about accessibility and how we can be more accessible.

By 2030, we will also:



- Try out new ideas to help people with different needs enjoy and take part in our services.



- Make at least 3 new **digital tools** that help visitors take part and enjoy our services.

**Digital tools** are things like computer programmes and technology.



- Work with other organisations in Liverpool to help make the city more accessible for everyone.
